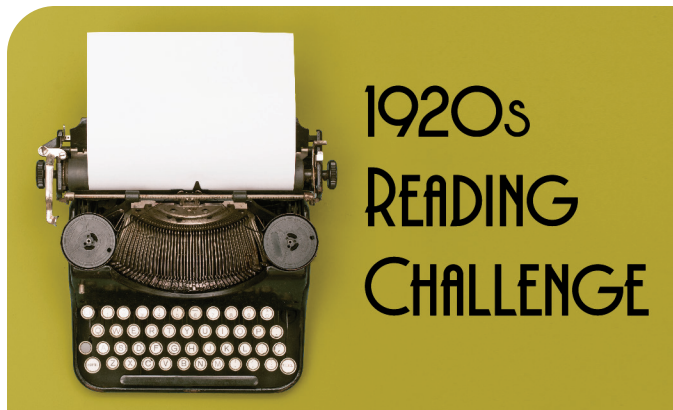

## Durham College Essential Skills:

### Food & Beverage Service

**Northview / Mon-Fri / Feb 20-Mar 1 / 10 am-2 pm**

This workshop is the first step in earning industry-specific certificates like Smart Serve or Safe Food Handling. It focuses on the knowledge and basic skills necessary to succeed in the food and beverage sector. In partnership with the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program and the Canada Revenue Agency, OPL will host the tax preparation clinic. In March and April, eligible individuals with a modest income and simple tax situation may have their 2023 taxes prepared by a CVITP-approved volunteer, free of charge, through the Library. 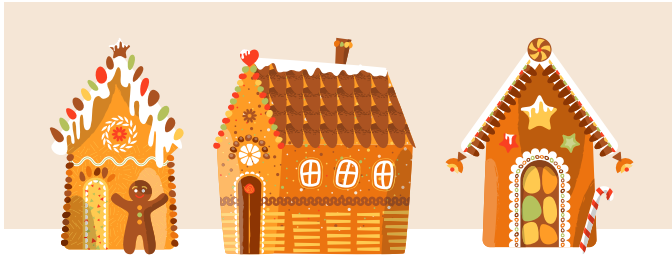

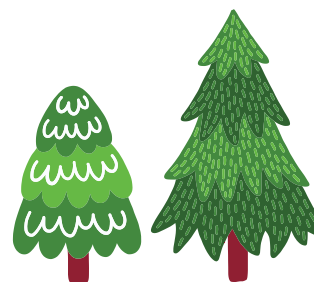

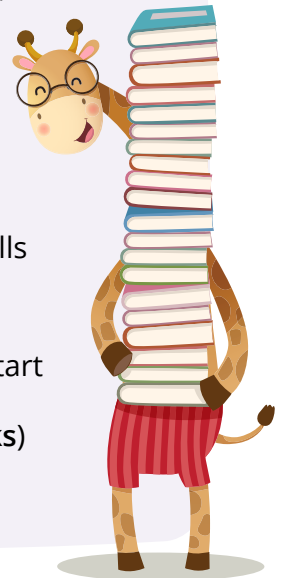
