Message From the CEO

Last year the Canadian Urban Libraries Council commissioned a study on the impact public libraries have on individuals. This was the first national study that was not designed to measure library use, satisfaction, or awareness of services, but instead asked respondents to consider several types of impacts the public library had on their lives. Twenty-six urban libraries across Canada took part in the study, including Oshawa.

The scope of the study was to measure the impact of print and digital collections, staff, programs, and spaces. One of the key findings was that there was agreement among both non-users and library users that libraries matter to individuals, communities, and society. Forty-two percent (42%) of non-users showed interest in using the library in the future but currently have no need or are too busy in their daily life. This highlights how non-library use is driven by one's current personal situation more than dissatisfaction with services offered.

Also of note was that those reporting the highest personal impact scores for library services were newcomers to Canada, parents with young children, and seniors.

Oshawa Public Libraries is committed to providing quality programs and services such as reading clubs, free special events, and a wide variety of reading materials in both print and digital formats to meet the needs of our community. Read on to find out all the wonderful things happening at the Library this summer.
